GREEN SCOUTS:

The Himalayan Green Scouts was formally started at SRS with the first batch of 45 students being enrolled in the troop. Another 51 students will be enrolled in 2026 completing the troop of 12 patrols focusing on Green activities and Biodiversity Conservation Awareness along with regular Scouting activities.

NATURE CLUB ACTIVITY REPORT, 2025

20th March: On World Sparrow Day, student members highlighted the three species found in Darjeeling through poster presentations in the school assembly.

21st March: On World Forest Day, the Nature Club students visited Lloyds Botanical Garden. Dr. Saibal Sengupta gave the group a talk on Forest ecosystems and the importance of forests.

2nd April: World Earth Day was celebrated wherein the students participated in an awareness cum conservation workshop organised by the PNHZ Park, Darjeeling.

27th and 28th April: Nature Club participated in the City Nature Challenge. They used Citizen Science based platforms to document the flora and fauna found in the urban landscape of Darjeeling. Under the supervision of Dr. Saibal Sengupta, the students secured 8th position in India and 1st position in the NE region. Sweekrit Thapa of 8D stood first with 500 plus observations.

8th May: A workshop on Mammal Conservation was organised by the Nature Club in collaboration with Centre for Wildlife Studies, Bengaluru. CWS Research Scholar and Dr. Saibal Sengupta conducted technical sessions and hosted interactive board games and reading sessions for participants from 4 schools.

17-19 May: 20 Nature Club students were invited to participate in a Wildlife Conservation event hosted by the Darjeeling Forest Division. The students attended several workshops at NIC, Maneybhanjyang and on 19th they trekked up to Tonglu documenting the biodiversity of the region.

22nd May: On the occasion of International Day for Biodiversity, a team of 15 students were taken for an exposure visit to Selphu/ Sittong area. They learned about compost making, organic farming, eco-tourism practices, and bee keeping.

5th June: World Environment Day was observed with an assembly presentation by the students who highlighted the need to reduce, recycle and reuse.

20th September: International Red Panda Day was observed by the Nature Club students at the PNHZ Park where a painting and mask making session was held for the students.

Throughout the year the Nature Club students took part in regular nature-based activities and Citizens Science initiatives.
